 - Wisconsin's state fossil, found in most limestone throughout the state
 - Impressions left behind from animals, includes burrows and footprints
 - What covered Wisconsin and Minnesota during the Ordovician period about 490 to 443 million years ago
 - Also know as sea lilies, they eat by filtering small particles of food from the sea water
 - Name means stomach foot, similar to the modern day snail
 - Type of rock that most fossils are found in
 - preserved remains or traces of animals, plants, and other organisms from the past
 - large squid like creatures with a hard outer shell
